PREVENTING DROWNING



THE NEED

Drowning is a leading cause of death among children, people of color, and individuals with medical conditions. Many members of our community have limited access to water safety instruction and therefore have significantly higher rates of drowning and injury related to water (CDC).

Y Aquatics programs can ensure children and families learn to safely enjoy activities in and around water and build healthy recreational skills for a lifetime.

- Water Safety daily instruction in Summer Camp
